## Generally allowed

- Hiking
- Birdwatching
- Bicycling
- Other non-motorized activities

We're happy to see you enjoy these activities on corridors we own, except where expressly prohibited. Abutting owners may have reserved rights, such as agricultural rights, that may limit these activities.



## May be permitted

- Snowmobiles and ATVs
- Hunting
- Wood harvesting

We work with landowners, abutters, state departments, sportsmen clubs, and others to balance the needs of landowners and the recreating public. Therefore, CMP may limit recreation on our corridors.



## Not allowed

- Tree stands and hunting blinds
- Unpermitted wood harvesting
- Dumping
- Structures including metal fencing other than for permitted agriculture
- 4x4 trucks, Jeeps, SUVs and/or dirt bikes

For CMP, safety comes first. These activities have been limited to ensure the safety of the public, our workers, and critical infrastructure.
