

PROJECT NOTIFICATION: Transmission Line Rebuild

Dear Neighbor:

As part of our commitment to providing safe, reliable service to our customers, Central Maine Power Company (CMP) will be rebuilding our electricity transmission system in your community beginning late 2024 and continuing into 2025.

Referred to as Section 1, the 34.5kV transmission line travels 23 miles from Augusta East Side Substation on North Belfast Avenue off Route 3 to Winslow Substation near Benton Road, serving approximately 8,000 customers. Built in 1929, the original transmission line needs replacement due to the age of poles, conductor, and crossarms; limited work clearances; and insulators that are prone to failure thus raising significant structural and reliability concerns. The upgrades will improve system resiliency to ensure that safe transmission of power is maintained.

The Maine Public Utilities Commission (MPUC) has approved the Section 1 rebuild from Augusta to Winslow. MPUC currently is considering a proposal to re-route a small portion of Section 1 into the existing Section 40 corridor, also in Winslow. This would require upgrades to the current Section 40 transmission line in this area. Section 1's existing two-mile route in Winslow would then be decommissioned and removed. By doing so, two transmission lines will be upgraded, and overall project and maintenance costs will be reduced.

CMP's current plan is to begin matting and corridor clearing in Augusta in the fourth quarter of 2024 and move northward towards Winslow. Our plans are presented in the enclosed Section 1 and Section 40 Transmission Lines fact sheet. We will share updates with you as we get closer to construction.
